This puppy feels **ANGRY, CROSS OR FURIOUS**.

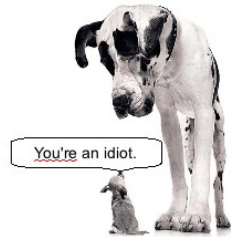
He doesn't look **FRIENDLY OR KIND**.

This cat is so **SELFISH**.

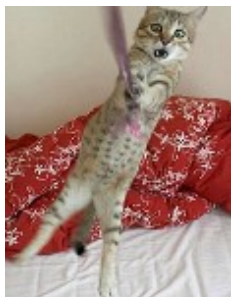
The dog looks very **PATIENT AND UNDERSTANDING**.
